SPECIAL INFORMATION

To be able to register, all currently enrolled students must have a Photo I.D. Card.

After currently enrolled students have met with their advisors and obtained clearance to register, students have the following registration options:

1. Web-Based registration.
2. Faculty members may enter the student's registration in their offices.
3. Admissions Office available for registration problems.

WEB REGISTRATION

July 23-August 16

Currently enrolled students can register on the web beginning July 23, 2007 through August 16, 2007. In order to use the web registration option each student will need his/her student number and personal identification number (PIN). All currently enrolled students **MUST** see their assigned advisors during July 23-August 3 for schedule approval and clearance to register. Students should make sure they have the correct call numbers for all classes for which they wish to register. In the event some classes are full, alternate call numbers should already be selected and approved by the advisor. Tuition and fees can be paid by credit card using web registration. All student information is encrypted to ensure the privacy and confidentiality of personal information.

DUAL ENROLLMENT/DUAL CREDIT REGISTRATION

July 30-August 3

High school students who enroll for the fall semester for dual enrollment/dual credit must submit the following items to the Admissions Office:

1. Completed application for admission.
2. Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Agreement Form completed and signed by superintendent and high school principal.
3. High school transcript.
4. ACT/COMPASS scores.

Students who do not register at this time will register at Open Registration, August 16, 2007. For further information, call Melissa Ryan at 331-5356.

Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit students will be awarded a 1/2 tuition scholarship for each dual enrollment course.

TRANSIENT STUDENT REGISTRATION

July 30-August 3

Transient students attending Northwest-Shoals Community College for the first time may take advantage of early registration for the fall semester. A completed application for admission and an approved transient letter must be submitted to the Admissions Office by July 20, 2007, to register early.

Students who have not submitted a completed application for admission and an approved transient letter by July 20, 2007 will register at Open Registration, August 16, 2007.

Registration Procedures

Registration is August 16, 2007

Students registering on the Phil Campbell Campus should report to the Administration Building. Students registering on the Shoals Campus should report to the Patriot Center.

The following steps are to be followed by First-time Freshmen, Transfers, Transient, Dual Enrollment, and Readmitting Students.

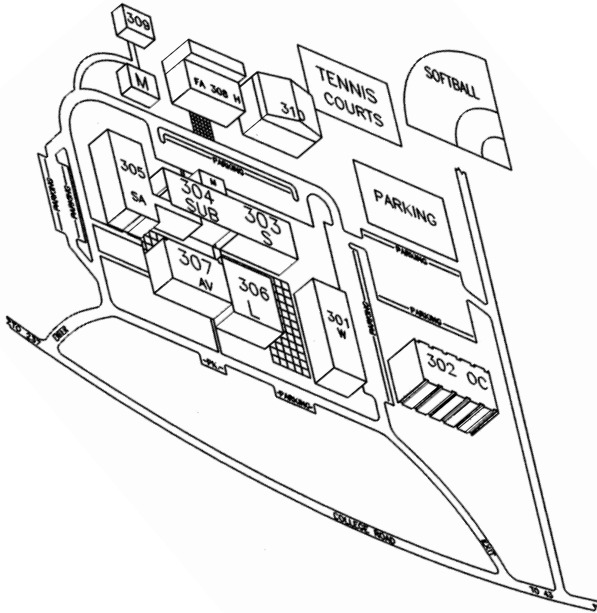
August 16 8:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. & 4:30 p.m.-7:00 p.m.

- Step 1. Report to **Check-In Station** of the appropriate campus.
- Step 2. If an application for admission or readmission has not been completed, go to the **Walk-In Work Area** to complete application. (A readmission application must be completed, if the student is not enrolled for the current semester.) If the application for admission has already been submitted to the Admissions Office, go to **Photo I.D. Station**.
- Step 3. **Photo I.D. Station:** Have picture taken for Photo I.D. and register vehicle for parking decal. Tag number is required to obtain parking decal.
- Step 4. **Testing:** Take COMPASS test, if appropriate. Students who have not successfully completed college-level English and/or math must take the COMPASS test, unless they made 20 or above on the math and/or English portion of the ACT College Entrance Exam. Then go to the **Advising Transcript Station** to obtain COMPASS scores and/or transfer credit and meet with assigned advisor to schedule appropriate classes.
- Step 5. Take completed registration form to the **Data Entry/Invoice Station** for processing. If any classes the student is registering for are full, go to the **Scheduling/Help Area** for assistance. Return to the **Data Entry/Invoice Station** to complete this step and receive printed invoice.
- Step 6. All students **must** go to the **Financial Aid Station** for financial assistance review.
- Step 7. Take invoice to the **Cashier Station** for payment of tuition and fees. All students whether paying tuition by cash, charging to a scholarship or financial aid program, must go to the **Cashier Station**. Schedules of students not completing this step will be cancelled. Pay tuition and fees by **7:00 p.m., August 16** to avoid cancellation of class schedule. Photo I.D. cards will be validated at the time tuition is paid.

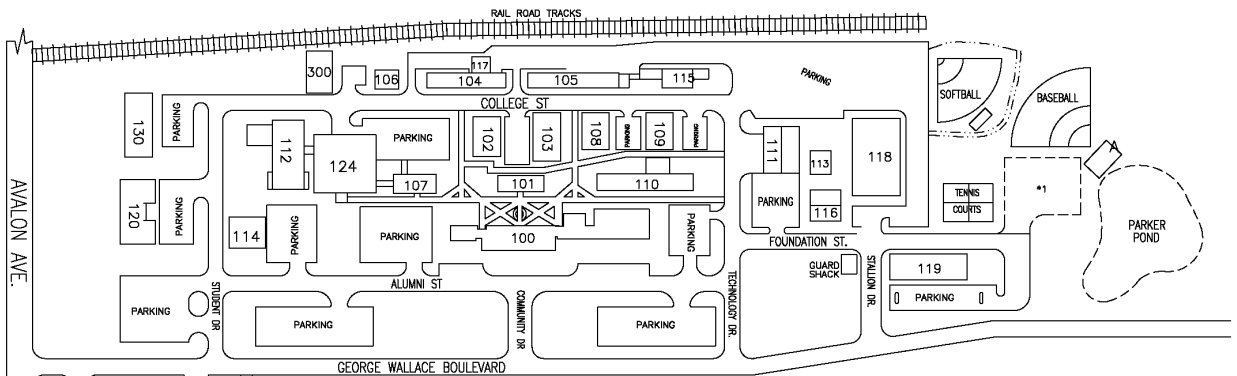

FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

To obtain information regarding financial help for your expenses at Northwest-Shoals Community College, visit our Financial Aid Offices or pick up an Application for Federal Student Aid.

Remember to apply for Federal Aid at least four to six weeks before classes begin. Personnel are available to help you complete the forms. Students may apply on-line using their Federal PIN at website www.fafsa.ed.gov. Additional aid is available through scholarships and outside sponsors for those who qualify.

Notice to Students: New/Transfer Students who have sent their application to Federal Student Aid and have not received a response within 3-4 weeks, please contact our offices. Students who have received their Federal Student Aid Report (yellow form), please bring it along with 2006 income information (1040 taxes) to the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible.

Deadline: Students must have Federal Pell Grants and Federal Stafford Loans approved by the Financial Aid Office prior to the August 16, 2007, Open Registration Day if charges are to be made. Students without prior approval should make plans to pay (cash, check, credit card) on the August 16, 2007, Open Registration Day. Reimbursements can be made later when students are officially approved for aid.

Financial Aid Offices are located on both the Shoals and Phil Campbell Campuses. In Muscle Shoals, the office is located on George Wallace Boulevard in Building 100. In Phil Campbell, the office is located in the Administration Building.

Ability to Benefit: Students who do not have a GED or high school diploma are permitted to use Federal Student Aid in a limited number of occupational programs. Students must pass all three parts of the ASSET or COMPASS tests at the same time before receiving aid. The test is free the first time and then \$8.00 thereafter.

Deadline for charges: Students on federal financial aid (Pell & SSLP) must make all charges in the Cashier's Office or Bookstore by August 24, 2007. All other financial aid charges end August 31, 2007.

FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID

Students on Federal Student Aid (Pell Grant & Loan) who totally withdraw from classes before the 60% point (October 26, 2007) in the semester may be required to repay a portion of their funds to the U.S. Department of Education, lender, or NW-SCC.

REFUND POLICY

A copy of the Refund Policy Number 803.02 issued Sept. 26, 1996, by the Department of Postsecondary Education, with guidelines for the policy, can be obtained from an employee in the Northwest-Shoals Community College Business or Admissions Office. For additional information concerning refunds from the College refer to pages 18-19 in the 2005-2006 College Catalog.

A sample of how the tuition refunds are calculated can be obtained by contacting an employee in the Northwest-Shoals Community College Cashier's Office.

Refund for Complete Withdrawal

A student who officially or unofficially withdraws from all classes before the first day of class will be refunded the total tuition and other institutional charges.

A student who officially or unofficially withdraws completely on or after the first day of class but prior to the end of the third week of class will be refunded according to the official withdrawal date, as follows:

Deadlines	Percent
1. Prior to August 20	100%
2. Withdrawal first week: August 20-24	75%*
3. Withdrawal second week: Aug. 27-31	50%*
4. Withdrawal third week: September 3-7	25%*
5. After September 7	0%

***Administrative Fee** - An administrative fee not to exceed five (5) percent of tuition and other institutional charges or \$100, whichever is smaller, shall be assessed in addition to the reduced percentage, for each withdrawal within the period beginning the first day of class and ending at the end of the third week of class.

Refund for Partial Withdrawal - Students who do not completely withdraw from the College but drop a class during the regular drop/add period will be refunded the difference in tuition paid and the tuition rate applicable to the reduced number of hours, including fees appropriate to the classes dropped. There is no refund due to a student who partially withdraws after the official drop/add period.

Student ID Conversion:

In June 2006, Northwest-Shoals Community College discontinued the use of Social Security numbers as Student Identification numbers to help keep your identity safe. Each student will be assigned a new ID number to be used for all areas of the College. The new ID number will appear on the NW-SCC OneCard, the College's official student ID card. It is important to have this card with you at all times, especially to access areas such as Bookstore, Library, and Testing Center.

SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT

Tuition for credit classes is free for persons 60 years or older. All other fees are calculated at the normal rate. A 10% discount can be applied to non-credit continuing education classes. Admission requirements are the same for all students, and all classes are available for audit if students have met course prerequisites listed in the course description.

The Automotive Service Technology department offers two programs: **Basic Certificate**-25 semester hours (two semesters) and **Advanced Certificate**-24 semester hours (two semesters).

Advanced Welding Technology

The Welding Program at NW-SCC is designed to develop the skills necessary to enter and maintain a job in the welding field. The Welding Program is equipped with manual and automated equipment to provide excellent training for new students as well as welding professionals who only need a two week upgrade to enhance their skills. New students as well as working professionals will be given specialized training provided by instructors that are AWS Certified Welding Inspectors. Students will be trained to operate advanced equipment in robotic welding, orbital welding and CNC plasma.

Students enrolled in the NW-SCC Welding Program will develop the skills necessary to pass a certification test that meets the requirements of the American Welding Society (AWS) D1.1 Code or API 1104 Pipe Code. Applicants are not required to have completed any particular subject prior to enrollment. The current Welding curriculum is taught during the day as well as evenings to fit any work schedule or job.

Furthermore, NW-SCC has developed a new mobile welding lab to provide onsite instruction and certifications to local business and industry. The mobile unit will include shielded metal arc welding, gas tungsten arc welding, gas metal arc welding and flux cored welding. The Advanced Welding Program is eager to offer upgrade training and certification to the NW-SCC community.

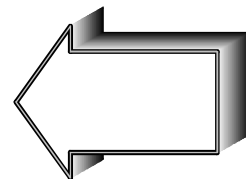

VIDEOCONFERENCING COURSES

The videoconferencing system is a network of classrooms connected by compressed-video technology. The classrooms are equipped with cameras, monitors, and other equipment that allows teachers and students to interact as if they are in the same room. Instructors can use traditional visuals, such as slides, videotapes, and overhead transparencies.

BLENDED COURSES

Blended courses require students to come on-campus for certain activities such as labs, presentations, or speeches. Students complete the lecture portion of the class without coming to campus.
